<p><b>ABORTION</b> Ban or legal?</p>	<p><b>Legal.</b> “<a href="#">Every woman</a> should have the right to make decisions about her own body.” “<a href="#">This fight</a> is about freedom.” With Biden, strengthened <a href="#">abortion pill</a> access and abortion patient <a href="#">protections</a>, <a href="#">overturned</a> Trump Planned Parenthood federal funding ban. Would sign national <a href="#">abortion rights</a> bill if Congress passed.</p>	<p><b>Ban.</b> “After 50 years of failure, I was able to <a href="#">kill Roe v. Wade</a>.” Did so <a href="#">by appointing</a> three anti-abortion Supreme Court <a href="#">Justices</a>. It was “a <a href="#">miracle</a>.” <a href="#">States</a> should decide for themselves, potentially monitoring women’s pregnancies and <a href="#">prosecuting</a> women for getting abortions. Abortion is “really <a href="#">not that big</a> of an issue.”</p>
<p><b>CLIMATE CHANGE</b> Should climate change be a top priority?</p>	<p><b>Yes.</b> <a href="#">We’re seeing</a> the climate crisis “every day...in real time.” “<a href="#">We must do more</a>.” Cast the <a href="#">deciding vote</a> to <a href="#">commit</a> \$369 billion to climate and clean energy, the <a href="#">biggest investment</a> in US history. <a href="#">Supported</a> \$1.2 trillion in <a href="#">infrastructure</a>; includes <a href="#">reducing</a> greenhouse gas emissions.</p>	<p><b>No.</b> Climate change is a “<a href="#">hoax</a>.” The world will “start <a href="#">getting cooler</a>.” <a href="#">Withdrew</a> from the Paris climate pact. Will <a href="#">expand</a> coal and oil production. “I want to <a href="#">drill, baby, drill</a>.” Asked oil and gas executives to <a href="#">donate</a> \$1 billion so he could <a href="#">reverse</a> Biden’s climate initiatives.</p>
<p><b>CRIMINAL JUSTICE</b> How to ensure effectiveness and fairness in law enforcement?</p>	<p>Police are <a href="#">dedicated public servants</a>. As a prosecutor <a href="#">increased felony convictions</a> by one third. But “<a href="#">public safety</a> requires community trust.” <a href="#">Has supported</a> better training, banning choke holds, and prosecuting police misconduct.</p>	<p><a href="#">Police</a> are “under siege.” <a href="#">Cut back</a> active federal oversight of excess force, though supported a <a href="#">database</a> to track it. <a href="#">Admires</a> Chinese approach of quick trials and a death penalty for drug dealers so there will be a “zero drug problem.”</p>
<p><b>EDUCATION</b> Limit teaching about racism and gender identity?</p>	<p><b>No.</b> In Florida “<a href="#">extremists</a>... passed a law, ‘Don’t Say Gay,’ trying to instill fear in our teachers.” Now, “they want to <a href="#">replace history</a> with lies,” teaching “that enslaved people benefited from slavery.” Children should be “<a href="#">taught the truth</a>.”</p>	<p><b>Yes.</b> Certify teachers who “<a href="#">embrace</a> patriotic values.” Would “<a href="#">cut</a> federal funding” for any school “pushing critical race theory, gender ideology.” <a href="#">Restricted</a> diversity training for federal employees and contractors.</p>
<p><b>ELECTIONS</b> Did Joe Biden win the 2020 Presidential election?</p>	<p><b>Yes.</b> “The [election] results <a href="#">were certified</a> by state after state and reaffirmed by court after court.” “On January 6, <a href="#">we all saw</a> what our nation would look like if the forces who seek to dismantle our democracy are successful.”</p>	<p><b>No.</b> Called the election a “<a href="#">Big Lie</a>” and a “<a href="#">Massive Fraud</a>” that would justify “termination” of parts of Constitution. Called those who stormed U.S. Capitol “<a href="#">unbelievable patriots</a>.” Would <a href="#">pardon</a> them fully.</p>
<p><b>ENVIRONMENT</b> Loosen or tighten environmental regulations?</p>	<p><b>Tighten.</b> <a href="#">Supports</a> “environmental justice.” In CA <a href="#">prosecuted</a> polluters. Biden admin <a href="#">issued</a> more than 100 environmental regulations.</p>	<p><b>Loosen.</b> <a href="#">Weakened or ended</a> more than 125 environmental <a href="#">protections</a>, including wetlands and wildlife. Will <a href="#">reverse</a> Biden policies.</p>
<p><b>GUN LAWS</b> Loosen or tighten gun regulations?</p>	<p><b>Tighten.</b> “Every person deserves the freedom to live <a href="#">safe</a> from gun violence.” <a href="#">Supported</a> the bipartisan gun safety bill and <a href="#">required</a> background checks for gun show &amp; online sales.</p>	<p><b>Loosen.</b> To NRA, “<a href="#">no one will lay a finger</a> on your firearms.” Plans to <a href="#">roll back</a> Biden gun restrictions. <a href="#">Reversed</a> Obama-era background checks for those with mental illnesses.</p>
<p><b>HEALTHCARE</b> Repeal or expand the Affordable Care Act (ACA), also known as Obamacare?</p>	<p><b>Expand.</b> “<a href="#">Health care is a right</a>, not a privilege.” <a href="#">Cast</a> a tie-breaking Senate vote to expand ACA &amp; <a href="#">lower</a> Medicare drug prices, including a \$35 monthly <a href="#">insulin cost</a>. <a href="#">Would link</a> drug costs to costs that comparable wealthy nations pay.</p>	<p><b>Repeal.</b> “<a href="#">Terminate</a>.” “Obamacare is a <a href="#">catastrophe</a>.” As President, <a href="#">promised</a> to replace it with “something terrific,” but repeal failed in the Senate by one vote. <a href="#">Supported</a> an unsuccessful lawsuit to overturn it.</p>

<b>IMMIGRATION</b> How to handle immigration? Support a path to citizenship for “DACA” participants brought to the US as children?	<b>Supports</b> “comprehensive immigration reform.” <b>Backed</b> the bipartisan Senate border security bill. <b>Rejects</b> mass deportation of undocumented immigrants. “We are a nation of immigrants.... <b>let us all address</b> [the issue] with the urgency and seriousness it requires.” Supports pathways to citizenship for <b>DACA participants and</b> undocumented <b>spouses</b> of citizens.	Illegal immigrants are “ <b>poisoning the blood</b> of our country.” Will use the National Guard and local police, with possible detention camps, to deport <b>15 to 20 million</b> illegal immigrants. <b>Opposed</b> the bipartisan Senate immigration bill. <b>Tried</b> to end DACA; Supreme Court <b>overruled</b> . <b>Would</b> renew his Muslim ban and end automatic citizenship for everyone born in US.
<b>ISRAEL/GAZA</b> Response to Israel’s invasion of Gaza following October Hamas attack?	“ <b>We need</b> ” a cease-fire & a two-state solution. “Israel has <b>a right</b> to defend itself.” But “ <b>too many innocent</b> Palestinians have been killed... Civilian suffering... [is] devastating.” Palestinians and Israelis both “ <b>are entitled to security</b> .”	Has <b>supported</b> Israeli action, “get the job done.” Says Israel <b>releasing images</b> of bombed Gaza buildings loses “the PR war.” Gaza protesters are “ <b>raging lunatics</b> and Hamas sympathizers.” Would <b>deport</b> student protesters.
<b>LABOR</b> Make it easier or harder for unions to organize?	<b>Easier</b> . “ <b>Unions built</b> ” the American middle class. “We are fighting to protect the <b>sacred right</b> to organize.” Backs pro-union <b>laws</b> . <b>Walked UAW picket line</b> . Build “ <b>an economy</b> where every person, not just the wealthy,” can thrive.	<b>Harder</b> . <b>Made it harder</b> for unions to win representation and <b>organize</b> on an employer’s property. <b>Restricted</b> federal employee collective bargaining. Striking Auto Workers were “ <b>sold down the river</b> by their leadership.”
<b>LGBTQ RIGHTS</b> Limit or expand LGBTQ rights?	<b>Expand</b> . In 2004, <b>officiated</b> some of the nation’s first same-sex marriages. <b>Helped repeal</b> California’s anti-gay marriage initiative. Biden administration <b>protected</b> LGBTQ medical patients from discrimination.	<b>Limit</b> . <b>Weakened</b> an Obama order protecting LGBTQ federal contractors from discrimination. <b>Banned transgender</b> military servicemembers and <b>ended</b> anti-discrimination protections for transgender patients.
<b>MARIJUANA</b> Ban or legal?	<b>Legal</b> . “ <b>Nobody</b> should have to go to jail for smoking weed.” <b>Legalize</b> and regulate. <b>Supports</b> Biden’s easing federal prohibition.	<b>Unclear</b> . It <b>does</b> “significant damage.” <b>Reversed</b> Obama rule to not prosecute in states where legal, but ultimately <b>didn’t</b> prosecute.
<b>MINIMUM WAGE</b> Raise federal minimum from \$7.25 an hour?	<b>Yes</b> . <b>Supports</b> Congress raising the national minimum wage to <b>\$15</b> . Biden administration raised to <b>\$15</b> for federal contractors.	<b>No</b> . A \$15 minimum wage <b>would</b> “eliminate jobs.” <b>Threatened</b> to veto. Questioned need for a federal minimum wage: let the <b>states decide</b> .
<b>SOCIAL SECURITY</b> Cut Social Security or raise retirement age to stabilize program?	<b>No</b> . Would <b>protect</b> and stabilize Social Security <b>by</b> making wealthier Americans pay into Social Security at the same rate as everyone else; they’d keep paying in above their <b>current</b> \$168,600/year income cap.	<b>Mostly yes</b> . There’s “ <b>a lot you can do</b> in... cutting.” Also flags bad management. Proposed <b>\$35 billion cuts</b> in Social Security disability programs. But “ <b>will never do</b> anything” to “hurt Social Security.”
<b>STUDENT FINANCIAL AID</b> Support lowering interest on student loans and/or forgiving them?	<b>Yes</b> . <b>Supported</b> Biden forgiving \$144 billion for over 4 million borrowers, after the Supreme Court blocked the Biden-Harris <b>\$430 billion</b> forgiveness plan.	<b>No</b> . <b>Called</b> student loan forgiveness “unfair” to those not attending college. <b>Vetoed</b> forgiving loans of defrauded students. <b>Proposed cutting</b> support programs for student borrowers.
<b>TAXES</b> Raise or lower taxes on the wealthy and corporations?	<b>Raise</b> . <b>Voted against</b> Trump tax cuts, which included the <b>largest</b> corporate cut in US history. <b>Supported</b> increasing corporate tax rates. To boost teacher salaries, <b>proposed</b> raising estate taxes on the very wealthy.	<b>Lower</b> . His 2017 <b>tax cut</b> included the largest corporate cuts in US history and major tax cuts for the wealthy. <b>Would</b> extend them when they expire in 2025. <b>Raising</b> business taxes “will lead to the destruction of your jobs.”
<b>UKRAINE/RUSSIA</b> Support defending Ukraine against Russian invasion?	<b>Yes</b> . “Regarding Putin’s unprovoked, unjustified war against Ukraine... we are <b>committed</b> to... defend democratic values and stand up to dictators.”	<b>Mostly no</b> . To end the war, will push Ukraine to <b>give up territory</b> to Russia. Russia <b>should</b> “do whatever the hell they want” to NATO countries that don’t pay enough.
<b>VOTING RULES</b> Make voting harder or easier?	<b>Easier</b> . <b>Pass</b> bills to <b>protect voting rights</b> and make voting and registration easier. Biden administration <b>directed</b> federal agencies to help people register.	<b>Harder</b> . Has <b>long supported</b> stronger voter ID requirements. <b>Sued</b> to bar ballot drop boxes. Encouraged Republicans to vote early but said <b>early ballots</b> “get lost” or are “phony.”
