ORDERED that DSCC Plaintiffs' Renewed Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, ECF 163, is **GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART**¹; and it is further

ORDERED that LULAC Plaintiffs' Renewed Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, ECF 171, is **GRANTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that NAACP Plaintiffs' Renewed Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, ECF 172, is **GRANTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the United States Postal Service is preliminarily enjoined from implementing and enforcing the Final Rule it published on August 21, *see* Ballot Mail for Federal Elections, 91 Fed. Reg. 54,966 (Aug. 26, 2026).
