ABORTION Ban or legal?	Legal. <u>Supports</u> the <u>Women's Health</u> <u>Protection Act</u> to federally protect abortion access. " <u>Will oppose</u> any judicial nominee who does not support abortion rights." <u>Opposes</u> efforts in Congress to defund Planned Parenthood.	<b>Mostly legal</b> . In 2022, <u>vetoed</u> the <u>Abortion Care</u> <u>Access Act</u> ; it expanded the pool of authorized abortion providers. <u>Withheld funding</u> designated to train new providers. In 2024 said <u>supports</u> "restoring Roe as the law of the land" and <u>would</u> add abortion rights to federal law.
CLIMATE CHANGE Should climate change be a top priority?	Yes. " <u>Urgent action</u> is necessary to address the climate crisis." Climate change, is " <u>an existential</u> threat for all of our families and children." <u>Supports</u> Biden climate change laws, including <u>\$369 billion</u> in clean energy spending and funding to <u>reduce</u> greenhouse gases.	<b>Mostly yes</b> . <u>Adopted</u> Biden's <u>Better Climate</u> <u>Challenge</u> , & <u>joined</u> the U.S. Climate Alliance. Let Maryland's <u>Clean Energy Jobs Act</u> become law without his signature. <u>Preferred</u> his <u>plan</u> , featuring nuclear energy. <u>Canceled</u> the Baltimore mass transit Red Line with \$300M already invested; shifted state funds to roads.
<b>CRIMINAL JUSTICE</b> How to ensure effectiveness and fairness in law enforcement?	" <u>Believes</u> in the need for comprehensive changes that promote safety, justice, and equity for all residents." <u>Implemented</u> reforms enhancing police accountability. " <u>Everyone has</u> the right to feel secure" in their homes, schools, businesses.	<u>Boosted</u> police funding, calling it "re-fund the police." <u>Vetoed</u> police reform bills, including body-camera mandates and limits on "no- knock" warrants. <u>Let a bill</u> become law without his signature that created a state unit to investigate police-involved deaths.
<b>ECONOMY</b> Decrease or increase government investment in, and regulation of, the economy?	Increase. <u>Supports</u> "critical investments into our future economy to ensure businesses [can] compete with companies around the globe." Advocates for " <u>investing in humans</u> ": "When I think about true economic opportunity, I think about things like a child tax credit."	Mixed. "Instead of more reckless government spending, our plan demands real fiscal responsibility." As governor, " <u>eliminated or</u> <u>rewrote</u> thousands of job-killing regulations." In 2021 <u>asked Congress</u> to speed up approval of infrastructure projects.
<b>ELECTIONS</b> Did Joe Biden win the 2020 Presidential election?	Yes. "MAGA Republicans " <u>undermined our</u> <u>elections</u> and democratic processes and led an armed insurrection against our Capitol."	<b>Yes</b> . <u>Accusations</u> without evidence of a stolen election were "really bad for our democratic process."
<b>ENVIRONMENT</b> Loosen or tighten environmental regulations?	<b>Tighten</b> . As county executive, increased <u>stormwater management</u> to protect the Chesapeake Bay. Supports <u>additional funding</u> for Bay clean-up; the Bay should be named a <u>National Recreation Area</u> . <u>Expanded</u> a countywide curbside composting program.	<b>Mixed</b> . <u>Signed a bill banning</u> fracking in 2017. Opposed clean energy legislation in <u>2016</u> and <u>2022</u> , though allowed the 2022 bill to become law without signing it. <u>Proposed</u> his own set of clean energy goals in 2019. <u>Eased regulations</u> on industrial poultry farm emissions.
GUN LAWS Loosen or tighten gun regulation?	<b>Tighten</b> . " <u>Current</u> gun laws are inadequate." <u>Supports</u> universal background checks and closing the gun show loophole; would ban military-style weapons and bump stocks. <u>Supports</u> "red flag" laws.	Mixed. <u>Relaxed</u> rules on concealed handguns after a U.S. Supreme Court ruling. <u>Vetoed</u> tougher background checks on gun transfers. <u>Let</u> a "ghost guns" ban take effect without signing it. <u>Signed</u> a "red flag" law.

HEALTHCARE Increase or decrease government support for health care? Support or oppose Obamacare?	Increase. " <u>Healthcare</u> is a fundamental right As Senator, I will work to defend and build upon the Affordable Care Act." <u>Supports</u> universal paid family and medical leave policies.	<b>Mostly increase.</b> <u>Defended</u> Obamacare against a 2017 proposal to repeal it. In 2018 <u>signed</u> a bill to strengthen publicly supported health care. <u>Vetoed</u> partially paid family medical or care leave.
<b>IMMIGRATION</b> How to handle immigration and the border? Support a path to citizenship for "DACA" participants brought to the US as children?	<u>Supports</u> "comprehensive immigration reform" with "a pathway to citizenship" for those already living in the U.S. <u>Backs</u> a <u>path</u> to permanent residence for DACA participants. Allow <u>undocumented</u> immigrants to get a driver's license & "legally commute to work."	" <u>Our open</u> southern border is a humanitarian catastrophe that is harming communities and wreaking havoc." <u>Supports</u> "bipartisan, commonsense solutions." As governor, <u>vetoed</u> "sanctuary state" status for undocumented immigrants.
LABOR Make it easier or harder for unions to organize?	<b>Easier</b> . Is " <u>committed</u> to protecting workers' rights." <u>Supports a bill</u> to strengthen collective bargaining rights and protect the right to organize.	Harder. <u>Vetoed</u> bills to expand collective rights for college employees. In 2016 <u>called</u> teachers' union leaders "thugs."
LGBTQ RIGHTS Limit or expand LGBTQ rights?	<b>Expand</b> . As county executive, <u>appointed</u> the county's first LGBTQ liaison to link the community to resources. <u>Supported</u> same-sex marriage rights in Maryland. "Will <u>continue</u> to stand up for" LGTBQ rights. "Will… oppose… efforts to <u>undermine equality</u> ." <u>Opposes</u> anti-transgender legislation.	<b>Mixed.</b> Let LGBTQ protections become law without his signature. Let a ban on the anti- LGBTQ "panic" defense become law without his signature. Signed a ban on "gay conversion therapy" for minors. Opposed a transgender rights law in 2014 while accepting the state's same-sex marriage law.
MARIJUANA Ban or legal?	<b>Legal with limits</b> . " <u>What</u> adults choose to do is their business." <u>Has</u> concern about "impact on youth." As county prosecutor, <u>blamed</u> rising crime rates on decriminalized marijuana.	<b>Mixed</b> . Let a <u>companion bill</u> to voter-approved legalization become law without his signature. In 2015 <u>vetoed</u> decriminalization. In 2016 <u>vetoed</u> decriminalization of possession of marijuana paraphernalia.
MINIMUM WAGE Raise the federal minimum from \$7.25/hour? If raise, how much?	Yes. <u>Supports</u> increasing the minimum wage to \$15; "believes it should be done federally." <u>Would</u> index the minimum wage to inflation so it rises with the cost of living.	<b>Unclear</b> . No position found on the federal minimum wage. <u>Vetoed</u> raising Maryland's minimum wage to \$15; <u>proposed</u> raising to \$12.10 per hour instead.
<b>STUDENT FINANCIAL AID</b> Support lowering interest on student loans and/or forgiving them?	Yes. <u>Supports</u> Biden's student loan forgiveness plan and "improving access to low interest student loans." <u>Would expand</u> Pell Grants to assist low-income students.	No. Biden's plan is "a really <u>bad</u> idea at the worst possible time." Supported student loan <u>tax credits</u> , <u>scholarships</u> , and <u>capping tuition</u> <u>growth</u> as other solutions.
TAXES Raise or lower taxes on corporations and wealthier individuals?	<b>Raise</b> . " <u>We need</u> leaders who [will] make big corporations pay their fair share." Would <u>raise</u> the corporate tax rate to create more equity and allow economic growth "that benefits more people in the middle."	<b>Likely lower</b> . <u>Supported</u> the 2017 Trump tax cuts, which included the <u>largest</u> corporate cut in US history.
<b>VOTING RULES</b> Make voting harder or easier?	<b>Loosen</b> . <u>Supports legislation</u> to enforce voting rights and expanding voting access.	<b>Mixed</b> . Let voting legislation become law without his signature, including expanded <u>vote-by-mail</u> , expanded <u>early voting</u> , and <u>automatic</u> voter registration. <u>Vetoed</u> voting rights for released felons.
