Overview:

Federal funding bills determine how government programs, such as housing, health care, education, and other critical programs, are funded and maintained. Congressional funding decisions shape how tax dollars are allocated and directly affect the services our communities rely on. When Congress threatens a shutdown, or makes major budget cuts, it weakens support for Black families, workers, students, and other everyday Americans. Legislative Scorecards show voting records, make priorities visible, hold lawmakers accountable, and highlight the impact of their decisions on our communities.

In 2025, Congress advanced several significant funding measures that could undermine progress from essential programs while also facing high-stakes showdowns over short-term spending bills. Together, these actions are shaping the resources available to our communities and the stability of programs and services people depend on every day. The attached scorecards highlight how each Member of Congress voted on six key bills, providing our members with the information they need to direct their advocacy effectively.



Continuing Resolution (CR) Votes and Shutdown Risk

September 19, 2025

Congress considered three short-term funding proposals (“continuing resolutions” or CRs) to avoid a government shutdown.

Key Votes:

- **House-Passed CR (H.R. 5371)** Passed the House on September 19, 2025.
 - Would have funded the government through November 21, 2025 at current levels.
- **Senate Vote on the House CR (H.R. 5371)**
 - Same day, the Senate rejected the House plan in a 44–48 vote.
 - Fell short of the 60 votes required for passage.
- **Senate Democrats’ Alternative CR (S. 2882)**
 - Introduced earlier that day by Senate Democrats.
 - Also failed, 47–45, below the 60-vote threshold.

Why This Matters:

- CRs are short-term fixes to keep government programs operating while Congress finalizes full budgets.
- The failure of both proposals increased the risk of a government shutdown.

Continuing Appropriations and Extensions and Other Matters Act, 2026 (S. 2882)

This bill provides continuing FY2026 appropriations for federal agencies, permanently extends the expanded premium tax credit for purchasing health insurance, provides additional funding for Medicaid and security for federal officials, and extends various expiring programs.

The CR funds most programs and activities at the FY2025 levels with several exceptions that provide funding flexibility and additional appropriations for various programs. For example, the CR provides additional funding for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting and security for federal officials.

In addition, the CR:

- Permanently extends provisions that expanded the premium tax credit, which generally reduces premiums for health insurance purchased through a health insurance exchange.
- Repeals health care provisions that were included in the One Big Beautiful Bill Act, including provisions that reduced Medicaid funding.
- Authorizes the District of Columbia to spend local funds at the rates included in its FY2026 local budget.
- Extends the availability of certain funds that are being withheld by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).
- Limits the authority of OMB to withhold appropriations.

The Rescissions Act of 2025 (Public Law 119-28) was signed into law on July 24, 2025

A rescission bill is a piece of legislation that cancels or withdraws previously approved budget authority for federal spending. Essentially, it allows the government to reverse its decision to spend money on a specific project or program.

This law takes back approximately \$9.4 billion in previously allocated federal funds from public broadcasting, foreign aid and international programs, democracy and crises funds, peacekeeping, and clean tech funds.

Funding Taken Back:

- \$7.9 billion from foreign aid assistance (USAID, Global Health, Refugee Aid, U.S. Institute of Peace, U.S. African Development Foundation, Inter-American Foundation, Clean Tech Fund, Democracy and Crises Fund, Peacekeeping)
- \$1.1 billion from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting Service (PBS), National Public Radio (NPR), and over 1,500 local stations

The One Big Beautiful Bill Act Act/
H.R. 1/Public Law No: 119-21



The One Big Beautiful Bill Act (OBBBA) or the Big Beautiful Bill (Public Law 119-21) was signed into law on July 4, 2025.

The Budget Reconciliation law has the largest cuts to essential needs programs in history. This law prioritizes tax breaks for the wealthy while gutting support for families with low incomes and placing new costs on states.

Health Care:

- Cuts over \$1 trillion to Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act (ACA) over a ten-year period with new national work requirements, copays, and stricter eligibility rules.
- Cuts to Medicaid, Medicare, and ACA coverage will result in 17 million people losing health insurance.
- These cuts will also cause closures of rural hospitals, community clinics, and health centers.

Nutrition Assistance:

- Cuts over \$186 billion from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), the nation's most important anti-hunger program.
- Imposes new work and eligibility requirements.

State Burden:

- Shifts some Medicaid and SNAP costs from the federal government to states.
- This will force cuts to other programs, like education, or lead to deeper reductions in health and nutrition services.

Debt & Fiscal Policy:

- Raises the debt ceiling by \$5 trillion.

Clean Energy:

- Phases out most clean-energy incentives (credits for wind and solar, EV rebates, energy-efficient appliance rebates, electric truck and bus manufacturing).
- Rescinds clean energy funds from the Inflation Reduction Act.

Education:

- Eliminates subsidized graduate loans and sets new limits on unsubsidized graduate loan amounts.
- Restructures income-driven repayment plans, potentially raising monthly payments and delaying loan forgiveness.
- In K–12 education, establishes a federal tax credit for donations to private school scholarship funds.
- Effects could reduce college access for low-income and working students, divert public funds to private schools, and increase pressure on under-resourced public schools.

Tax Policy:

- Makes permanent the individual tax cut rates from the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA).
- Primarily benefits wealthy earners and corporations.
- Experts warn this law creates the largest upward transfer of wealth from poor to rich in American history by pairing benefit cuts with tax breaks.

Vote Summary:

The House of Representatives passed the Senate version of the OBBBA in a final mostly party-line vote of 218–214. Republican moderate Brian Fitzpatrick and fiscal conservative Thomas Massie, along with all Democrats, voted against the bill.

NAACP President and CEO Derrick Johnson Statement:

"Make no mistake, this bill is not beautiful. It's brutal. It's a deeply destructive piece of legislation that undermines the very foundations of what it means to be an American. Not only does it slash funding for essential programs like Medicaid, SNAP, tax credits for the middle and working class, it deepens the nation's debt by over \$3 trillion – all to make billionaires wealthier."

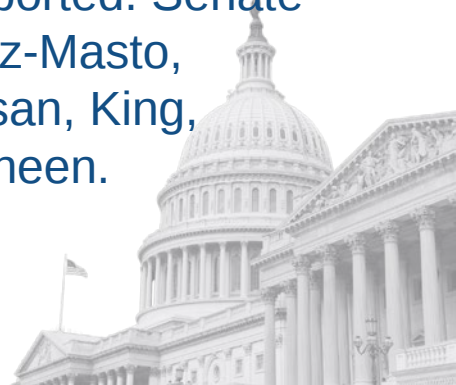
