ABORTION Ban or legal?	Ban. In 2020 <u>advocated</u> for a complete ban, no exceptions. In 2024 <u>supports</u> exceptions for rape, incest, and the life of the mother. "I want North Carolina to be the most pro-life state in the nation <u>Abortion is murder</u> ."	Legal. Would " <u>defend</u> women's rights" to "contraception, IVF or abortion." Would " <u>never</u> stop fighting" for "women's reproductive freedom." <u>Called</u> "many" parts of NC's new abortion law "unconstitutional."
CLIMATE Should climate change be a top priority?	No. Climate change is "junk science." Educators who teach climate science are "liars." Will "keep <u>the climate change cabal</u> out of this state." "We have now allowed those folks to dictate what we do based on <u>pseudoscience</u> ."	Yes. Sees a "climate emergency." "We need to <u>take swift action</u> to protect our planet." <u>Will</u> "work to prepare our state for the impacts of climate change." Supported incentives for rooftop solar and <u>would work</u> to dramatically reduce carbon emissions in North Carolina.
CRIMINAL JUSTICE How to ensure effectiveness and fairness in law enforcement?	Would <u>support</u> "our law enforcement officers" and "have their back." " <u>Elected officials</u> are not backing up police officers." Is " <u>committed</u> <u>to ensuring</u> they are trained, equipped, and held to the highest professional standard."	Will " <u>build genuine trust</u> between law enforcement and the communities they serve." Will "recruit and retain more <u>public- spirited officers</u> ." System should <u>treat every</u> North Carolinian "fairly, no matter their race or economic status."
EDUCATION Use public funding for private and/or for-profit schools?	Yes. Expand <u>voucher programs</u> so that public schools might become "a thing of the past." If schools "won't do right," parents should remove their children and " <u>make your own</u> <u>school</u> ." Public school teachers are " <u>wicked</u> <u>people</u> ."	No. A publicly funded voucher program "sucks money out of the public schools," putting rural counties without a large tax base " <u>behind the</u> <u>eight ball</u> ." "We need every marginal dollar we can find in the budget <u>to invest in our public</u> <u>schools</u> ."
EDUCATION Limit teaching about racism and gender identity?	Yes. <u>Supported</u> a bill limiting what students can be taught about racism; "Indoctrination" about racism is "in our classrooms." Children should not be told about " <u>transgenderism,</u> <u>homosexuality</u> , any of that filth."	No. "Unfair" treatment based on "race, sexual orientation" <u>harms students</u> "in ways that reverberate long after they leave school." <u>Urges</u> the "federal governmentto make sure our young people are treated fairly."
EDUCATION Increase funding for K–12 and higher education?	No. "Cutting the fat" out of the <u>education</u> <u>budget</u> is "essential." "School systems get better results on <u>less money</u> ."	Yes. North Carolina is 49th out of the 50 states in " <u>public school funding</u> as a share of our state's economy." <u>Will</u> "fight to fully fund our public schools and pay our educators more."
ELECTIONS Did Joe Biden win the 2020 Presidential election?	No. On January 6, people were "so mad" because Biden " <u>stole the election</u> ."	Yes. The claim that Biden stole the election is "downright dangerous." "Three years ago today, a violent mob attackedthe peaceful transfer of power and democracy itself."
ENVIRONMENT Loosen or tighten environmental regulations?	Loosen. Wants "responsible development of fossil fuels." "God is the one who has <u>blessed</u> us to have all this fuel under our feet. And not taking advantage of it is an affront to him."	Tighten. "Environmental protections" are " <u>important safeguards</u> for North Carolina's natural resources." "Fought to preserve" them and will "continue to push for clean air and

GUN LAWS Loosen or tighten gun regulation?	Loosen. More stringent <u>gun regulations</u> will "leave the law-abiding, patriotic citizens of this nation unarmed, and defenseless." Saw Parkland, Florida shooting survivors who advocate for gun control as " <u>spoiled,know it</u> <u>all CHILDREN</u> " and " <u>communists</u> ."	Tighten. Supports <u>universal background</u> <u>checks</u> , raising the age to buy an AR-15 rifle from 18 to 21, and <u>red flag laws</u> that allow courts to remove guns from people who pose a threat. North Carolina's <u>self-defense</u> law is "too loose."
HEALTHCARE Increase or decrease government support for healthcare? Support Medicaid expansion?	Decrease. "I'm <u>not in favor</u> of Medicaid expansion," where health care in NC would be "turned over to the federal government." <u>Would</u> "repeal" Obamacare. " <u>Healthcare</u> is neither a 'right' or a 'privilege,' it's a RESPONSIBILITY that lies with the individual."	Increase. "Every North Carolinian should be able to <u>get good health care</u> , no matter where you live or how much money you earn." <u>Worked</u> to "expand Medicaid" and "defend Obamacare."
IMMIGRATION How to handle immigration?	Applauds TX Governor Abbott's "efforts to secure our border." Would "crack down on sanctuary cities." "Illegal immigrants come into middle-class and lower-class neighborhoods"to "commit human trafficking violations, and sell drugs."	"I supported the recent, <u>bipartisan border</u> <u>security legislation</u> — the strongest in a generation." Joined other state attorneys general in a federal <u>court challenge</u> to the Trump decision to end DACA, for those brought to the U.S illegally as children. <u>Opposed</u> the Trump Muslim immigration ban.
LGBTQ RIGHTS Limit or expand LGBTQ rights?	Limit. "Homosexuality" is "filth." <u>Transgender</u> women should be arrested for using the bathroom corresponding to their gender identity. <u>Straight couples</u> are "superior" to gay couples. "God formed me" to <u>fight against</u> the push for LGBTQ rights.	Expand. <u>Opposed</u> Trump attempt to eliminate protections for "gender identity or sexual orientation" in federal grant regulations. <u>Fought</u> "attacks against LGBTQ+ North Carolinians."
MARIJUANA Ban or legal?	Ban. " <u>Strongly</u> " <u>opposes</u> marijuana legalization. <u>Struggles</u> with the idea of medical marijuana.	Mostly legal. <u>Would</u> decriminalize simple possession, expunge criminal records. "I'm very much open to studying the idea of <u>legal</u> <u>recreational cannabis</u> ."
MINIMUM WAGE Raise North Carolina minimum from \$7.25/hour?	No position found.	Yes. "I'll keep working to deliver economic security" by " <u>raising</u> the minimum wage."
STUDENT FINANCIAL AID Support lower interest on student loans and/or forgiving them?	No. "A simple proposition with student loans: if you took out a loan, pay it back. <u>I'll pay your</u> <u>student loan</u> if you pay my mortgage."	Yes. <u>Supports</u> student loan forgiveness in exchange for "at least a decade of serving the public." Secured loan forgiveness for students defrauded by <u>schools</u> and <u>"deceptive" loan</u> <u>companies</u> .
TAXES How to handle state taxation?	" <u>Cutting taxes</u> and reducing government spending have made us the best state in the country to do business."	<u>Proposes</u> a "Working Families Tax Cut," that would reinstate the state Earned Income Tax Credit to give financial relief to those making up to around \$50,000 per year. " <u>Working</u> <u>people</u> need more money in their pockets."
VOTING RULES Make voting harder or easier?	Harder. <u>Opposes</u> early voting; there should be "one day to vote," except for invalids. Supports Voter ID. Any <u>opposition to Voter ID</u> is "a complete insult to any intelligent adult," and "particularlyblack people."	Easier. Joined other attorneys general to defend provisions of the Voting Rights Act that protect "against racial discrimination in elections." <u>Supports</u> an independent redistricting commission to end gerrymandering in North Carolina.
