In 2016 <u>proposed a fracking</u> moratorium until environmental regs tightened.	Mostly no. Supports <u>American energy</u> <u>independence</u> by producing <u>coal</u> , <u>oil</u> , <u>gas</u> , <u>and</u> <u>renewable energy</u> .
