Social Media Toolkit: Protect Medicaid, Protect Our Communities

March 2025

Overview

As part of a coalition of civil rights and health equity organizations advocating for communities of color, we are releasing a report detailing how proposed Medicaid cuts would devastate millions of Americans, disproportionately impacting people of color. This toolkit provides key messages, suggested social media posts, graphics, and a call to action to help amplify this urgent issue.



Key Messages:

1. Medicaid is a lifeline for **42 million people of color**—these cuts put their health and financial security at risk.
2. **20.3 million Latinos**, 13.3 million Black Americans, 3.5 million Asian Americans, 700,000 Native Americans, and 200,000 Pacific Islanders **depend on Medicaid for healthcare.**
3. **Cutting Medicaid means higher medical bills**, lost access to essential care, and increased health disparities.
4. **Lawmakers must reject these cuts** and protect the health of millions of families.
