<u>Purpose:</u> This annual award recognizes, Branches and State/State Area Conferences for outstanding work in the implementation of the Association's strategic priorities and goals mandated by the National Board of Directors i.e., building membership, enhancing advocacy, rebuilding legal capacity, criminal justice, civil rights compliance, civic engagement and enforcement by governmental and non-governmental entities, economic empowerment, educational equity, health advocacy and political empowerment.

The Thalheimer Awards Committee considers the following criteria when selecting Branches and State/State Area Conferences for these awards:

- Submission of annual financial report and all required assessments;
- Quality of written submission (layout and content);
- Branch in good standing (not under administrative investigation);
- Representation of Branch and/or State/State Area Conference in core areas;
- Demonstrate work in the NAACP Programs areas;
- Types of documentation submitted with report;
- Number of people who benefited by the noted activities of the Branch and/or State/State Area Conference;
- The direct ownership that the Branch and/or State/State Area Conference had over the activities.
